Dear Mr. Hill,

I very much appreciate the information in your letter of 12/21 in response to mine of 11/20. I also appreciate and thank you for the time represented by the effort you report.

It is good of you to inform me of the means of reaching your search room by shuttle but that is presently beyond my capability.

If it is possible to check the files of the Office of Government Reports left by Mrs. Kathryn C. Balckburn whose last rank was, I believe, director, it may well be that records on me that include this Pearl Harbor material can be found. I have in mind no more than any file or files she may have had under my name.

Because of your effort I do not make a point of it with you but there have to be Department of Justice files relating to me prior to February 1940. I'd appreciate a copy of the 1940 card to which you refer.
