MEMORANDUM FOR MR. HENNER,  
DIRECTOR, FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION

Reference is made to your memorandum of February 17, 1940, transmitting twelve large envelopes turned over to the Special Agents by Harold Weisberg, who stated that the documents constituted the files of David D. Haynes, in which you request that after reviewing the material, you desire to be advised what, if any, action should be taken in the matter by the Bureau.

I am informed that the Attorney General has directed your Bureau to make an investigation of the alleged forgery of documents by Haynes that was the subject of recent discussion by the Dies Committee and it is assumed that the material you now submit involves other phases which should be given consideration.

These documents will be analyzed, and I shall be glad to advise you in due course as to our conclusion.
