- 1. During the course of a background investigation of a prospective Agency employee by the Security Division, National Security Agency, information was developed that three alleged Government employees are reportedly associating or have associated with the above-captioned individuals.
- 2. Files-of another Government agency reflect that Herold-WILSBER was dismissed on 23 June 1947 from the Department of State because of indirect association with representatives of foreign powers. Files further reflect that Mrs. Lillien WEISBERG admitted that both she and her husband were members of an organization cited by the Attorney General.
- 3. The aforementioned Government employees are as f lows: Mae-CROWLEY, nee STONE, a sister of Mrs. Lillian WEIGERING, reportedly a former employee of Naval-Ordnance-Laboratory; thin CM WEY, husband / of Mae-Stone CROWLEY, reportedly employed by Noval-Authore laboratory; and Robert STONE, brother of Mrs. Lillion WEIGHER, reportedly a former employee of the Bareau of Cangus but reachtly transferred to another agency of the Government.
