Dear Mr. Weisberg:

Recently, the Community Relations Service (CRS) received an internal memorandum asking all components of the Department of Justice to search their records for reference to a Freedom of Information/Privacy Act request made by you or in your behalf. Our log book showed no referrals or requests had been received or answered by CRS. Therefore, we have reviewed the request you made to the Department of Justice in your letter of June 8, 1977.

Pursuant to the information supplied, a search of the CRS file systems was conducted. We hereby inform you that there are no records or materials in CRS related to the subject matter of your request.

It should be pointed out that CRS does not maintain files which are retrievable by reference to the name of any individual. In order to reply to your request, therefore, CRS staff conducted a search of all file systems within the agency that might have contained materials relating to your request. The results were negative, as indicated above.
