To Guin Shea from Harold Weisberg, re my PA request/appeal 7/1/80

Although I included the attached Original Division record #912 (JIK) in the appeal I mailed you pesterday, I now smite you separately about it. I have added the mix underlyings.

Supposedly all records bear file identifications. This does not. I take that to mean that a good-faith search termet be made if limited to so-called recorded copies.

This copy was provided in belated 1980 compliance, so far partial compliance, with my request the Original Division dates at fay 21, 1977. It has not provided any explanation for the inordinate delay.

It also is responsive to an even earlier request, my four-year-old PA request, with which Criminal Division, having this record, has not complied and did not provide it in an effort to comply with my PA request. This, of course, is also true of the other JFK records sentioning my name that Criminal has and had.

I am the captioned subject of this meso. It is of the administrative division. It thus establishes that the administrative component has pertiant records and after more than four years has not provided them. Not even after your resinders were distributed.

It refers to a memorandum from OLC, OLC, therefore, has this and the related records and has not provided them efter more than four years and after pretending some compliance.

It and all other pertinent records, of which Criminal provided only some in belated compliance with the JK request only. The AS's copies are important because he was mis-informed (a police say of saying decedved and misleds) by subordinates. The cost, aside from somel and ethical considerations, as I think you say agree, has been considerable-and is far from fully paid. If what I am saying is not clear, please remed the pertinent portions of the appeal to which all the copies provided are attached.

Thus, at the very least, not fewer than four Departmental components have not complied with my 1976 PA request and despite my timely appeal, this and the related records were not provided on appeal.

The meso states that in an unsuccessful effort to find my earlier letter two files

were scarched, 129-11 and 129-012-5, the second making what is called "restricted" sections. (It does not say "classified.)

It therefore seems protty obvious that as a minimum and to everyone's knowledge any compliance with my PA request had to include these two known files.

I have also underlined the reference to "record cards." any such cards partaining to me are within my request. In this appeal I ask for expedited processing of them becomes if I have them it might be possible to expedite the long-stonewallod request. The sense in which these cards are referred to suggests rather strongly that everybody knows about them and what they hold. In turn this sanguests rather strongly that non-compliance was not accidental and was Department-wide. That all components failed in the same manner is not easy to believe.

If the long-locked partial under the fraven, "The Place of Justice is a Hallowed Place" had not been unlocked I'd suspect that someone was trying to do a number on me.

Can you forecast how such less or more than four more years it will require before a g ood-faith search is begin?
