Couple of weeks ago Phyllis asked me about some of my requests, not of the FBI. I told her I'd not be able to be certain now and had no way of searching but I thought that at the least some would be represented in the incomplete list I made and used in C.A. 75-1996, where the purpose was to show a pattern of deliberate noncompliance. I gave your office several copies at different times. One I recall was to Linda Robinson and I referred Phyllis to the records she left.

That list does include references to a number of requests that pertain to the autopsy and medical evidence, to the special groups brought together under Ramsey Clark, etc.

As best I now recall, that list was made up from what I could locate after a student went over my records to isolate every request. He was a heavy drinker who didn't show it and I did not become aware of the disaster brought about until it was too late.

Such questions would not exist today if the law had not be violated, deliberately, and if the Department had done what the Court told it to do re that list. It was supposed to look into the matters and report on them.

In any event the list does include some references to pertinent requests, from the descriptions in the list. Nobody knew there was the task force I reported to you recently, but not knowing about it I came as close as anyone could to asking for those records because I did it in terms of a panel rather than a "task force."
