This is to acknowledge receipt of your Freedom of Information-Privacy Acts (FOIPA) request by the FBI on October 31, 1975.

An exceedingly heavy volume of FOIPA requests has been received these past few months. Additionally, considerable scope have been imposed upon the FBI. for FOIPA matters, substantial delays in processing requests continue.

The FBI has 5,324 FOIPA requests on hand. Processing has begun, and is in various stages of completion on 992 of those cases. In an effort to deal fairly with any request requiring the retrieval, processing and duplication of documents, each request is being handled in chronological order based on the date of receipt. Please be assured that your request is being handled as released will be made available at the earliest possible date.
