This memorandum supplements my memorandum of February 23, 1940, which covered my reading of the material contained in the 12 large envelopes which purportedly were delivered to the Federal Bureau of Investigation by one Harold Weisburg, who stated that the documents constituted the files of David D. Mayne.

Attached to the memorandum of J. Edgar Hoover, Director of the F. B. I., to Assistant Attorney General O. John Hogge, dated February 24, 1940, are 22 exhibits covering various papers which were also purportedly taken from the files of Mr. Mayne by Heisburg and delivered to the F. B. I. A reading of these papers does not change the conclusion reached by me in the memorandum of February 23rd above-mentioned, which was that the evidence submitted fails to show a violation of any Federal statute.
