As you indicate, Brading was in this office on November 21, 1963 and again on November 22 (hour unknown). I have no recollection of the incident and a study of the correspondence "rings no bell".

We have no "Mr. Flowers" employed here, nor did we in November 1963.

Mr. Brading possibly could have obtained glimpses of President Kennedy from this building. However, a much taller building would block a direct view of the parade route (which in this end of town was on Harwood Street, one block east of the Federal Building). This office closed and we walked over to Harwood Street in order to get a good view of the President on November 22, 1963.

I have directed our local FBI's attention to your letter of June 25, 1969.

It is hoped that this information will be helpful to you.
