Reference is made to your letter dated March 24, 1964, and my letter dated April 8, 1964, concerning the laundry mark "30 080" which appears in the gray jacket identified by certain witnesses as the jacket of Lee Harvey Cswald.

Enclosed are two copies of a memorandum dated April 21, 1964, at Dallas, Texas, captioned, "Lee Harvey Oswald." This memorandum reveals the laundry mark and/or dry cleaning tag was not identified as originating from any cleaning or laundry establishment in the Greater Dallas, Texas, area. Cur investigation has been extended into the New Orleans, Louisiana, area endeavoring to identify these marks. However, there are over four hundred similar establishments in this area, which necessitates extensive investigation.

When the results of this phase of the investigation are received the information will be promptly furnished to you.
