

Fulbright Assails 'Professional Patriots,' Again Urges

BALTIMORE, March 12 (AP)—Sen. J. W. Fulbright, again urging attempts at cooperation with Soviet Russia in specific fields, denounced today what he called the tyranny of "flag-waving professional patriots."

Fulbright, Arkansas Democrat who heads the Senate Foreign Relations Committee, listed Sen. Everett M. Dirksen of Illinois and Rep. Gerald R.
