following:


I) In the DEA file there is false information
that shows complicity of that department employees
in my case. I enclose copies with my comments and
I am willing to take a lie-detector test to prove
that I am saying the truth.

II) Enclosed is a copy of one of my statements
before the press in which I accuse the DEA of compli-
city in my case.

Before beginning to make this public to the
press I believe that it is more rational to the DEA
interview me and between both sides analyze all the
the evidence in my case so that the DEA can see that
there is false information made up by someone.

My faith in this country's judicial system
after writing to the judge (copy enclosed) is at
point zero since I never received his reply. Through
this letter I appeal to you as my last resort so not
to loose total faith in this country's justice. I
ask that you order your employees to discuss with me
the circumstances of my case. Such an attitude is
against the law and could be useful for the DEA and
myself.
