Dear Mr. Harap,

Thank you for your kind letter, and for the back issues of your magazine, which I found interesting.

Whether or not I can supply you with a story for your June issue depends on when it closes. I expect to leave town Thursday late in the morning and won't return for about 5 or 6 days. However, I might be able to do something while I am away.

Several things occur to me. One is a story on the current grand-jury investigations of the "Evening" press to show the following things:

The job is necessary now, with the country at war, because it wasn't done before the war. It is a good job that is being done by the D of J

But it was the function of the Dies committee to have done this job. It received, up to the beginning of this investigation, \$385,000 for this purpose, which it spent instead, spreading dissunity, trying to break unions and union leaders (now waging a successful fight on the production front); a fight that would not have been possible had Dies succeeded), sniping at the administration and its program and allies (USSR, Great Britain, China), and failing or refusing to investigate the very persons and publications now investigated by the grand-jury, even after the Dies committee had knowledge of them. First, the committee, officially, took the position that these persons and publications constituted no menace; then it whitewashed them. Several examples to be given. In this connection, several examples from the committee's record and reports, either in the text or photostats.

The committee failed to call before it a single one of the grand-jury witnesses (I have a complete list of the committee's witnesses and can compare it with the grand-jury list), and failed to investigate a single one of the publications (In connection with Social Justice Dies announced to investigate Coughlin "would necessitate a redefinition of the word 'un-American'" and Noah Mason said there was "no evidence Father Coughlin was connected with any un-American or subversive activities" - these are approximate quotes-I have them verbatim).

There are other who should be called by the D of J, for instance, Edward James Smythe, who was called before the Dies committee and failed

or insist I do repeat my story about the "Committee of 100" and how it was organized by myself and others to combat the Hitlerites. This committee, which was autocratic of its members, was affiliated with the Nazi Party, which had been obtained. Instead of doing something, Dies made an effort to whitewash Smythe and his backers, whose names Dies professed to know whatever I had discovered except to himself. In addition, several days ago I received a letter from Smythe, which has asked for them. And I have written him back, telling him that he can't get away with this. In short, Dies wrote a letter written and never published in which he had exposed Smythe. He says many nasty things like these : "Nazism and Hitlerism is Protestantism in action, the highest form of Christianity....We will strike like hell a lightning bolt. I am a report of Hitler's and we may do so, if we now need help. We will destroy Nazism and Communism in America, the only two forces that threaten us. Hitler rules in the rest of Germany. If I don't (Hitler) who goes on living Christian since Jesus Christ... and jobs among the doctored ones and all the people, we have to use machine guns to do. On the other hand, I'm not paid agent, except he hasn't gotten any money for it.

Also, the investigations and trials should mostly show who the backers, financial and otherwise, of these native Nazis and their papers are and have been (The D of J has the Social Justice list).

Congratulate the D of J and the administration (Washington report is that FDR cracked down on Biddle, who had forced the release of various Nazis who had been arrested right after Dec. 1). This is an international war against fascism, and these investigations and trials are an internal front against Hitler and his American would-be fifth column.

Another is the story of Nazi-connected cartels, as partially revealed before the Senate Patents committee by the D of J -but only partially. The papers have pretty much covered the facts as developed at the hearings, but I have photostatic copies of some of the original papers, showing the patents involved, etc. In addition (and this affects me personally, because I wrote the story involved), last June the House Patents Committee, whose chairman is Congressman Charles Kramer of Calif., sponsor of many Nazi-like bills and resolutions, instead of holding hearings on the subject of Nazi control of American production through patent and cartel arrangements, smeared as "blackmailers" the writer and publisher of a series of articles on this subject, and has since then suppressed the transcript of the open hearings. After this, Kramer tried to get his committee to issue a report along the same lines, but several Members refused to sign the report, so he made a one-minute speech on the floor of the House defending the company against the proven charges and then allowed this speech, which he subsequently "revised and extended" for two pages, to be sent out in large number under his frank. I have a copy of this reprint and the envelope in which it was mailed.

Both of these stories have been offered other publications, which have expressed an interest in them, and I'm offering them to you with the understanding that these others have first call, because they'll pay considerably more for the stories than you can. If they don't within a few days after I return to town, then they're yours, if you want them.

It's good you're here, I think we should have a talk. You can understand what we have in mind.

What do you think about the plan to
illustrate the two plots to basalts.

It's been long and arduous work, and has only just now begun.
I think it's a good idea, though it will take time.
The first stage is to map the area, then to identify the features that you might
want to illustrate in the maps, and then to draw them,
which will take some time, maybe a week or two.

It's important to make sure that the maps are accurate : each cell against
each other cell, and so on. It's also important to make sure that the features are
as accurate as possible. This will take time, but you can
do it quickly if you have a computer. I'll be available to help you with anything you need.
