Dear Mr. Weisberg:

Have just received your letter with material on the Air Corps enclosed. Many thanks. I will get on to this stuff in a day or two, then send it on to the Air Corps via you for checking.

The stuff from Lt. Schubert arrived Saturday but I still haven't been able to go over it very carefully. I did do the section for the book on the WAACs from a pamphlet he sent me and several releases I had previously received from Mr. Lehman. It's rather complete, but I do have one or two questions:

1. The pamphlet mentions that no further OCS candidates will be accepted by direct enlistment. Instead auxiliaries will be eligible for officer training. However, as that is one of the most important points, I wonder if we can't get some explanation of how an auxiliary will go about becoming a candidate for OCS training. I realize that it may be too soon for that. But maybe they can give me some notion.

2. The pamphlet lists salaries which coincide with the old salary schedule of army men. I assume this has been changed by the new pay bill. Will you check for me. Incidentally, the pamphlet made no mention of officers: their salaries, insignia, etc. Can you get me a list of all insignias (for enlisted gals as well as officers), and a complete salary chart for all.

I want to get this letter out right away so will leave other questions, if I have them, to later on, probably some time this evening.
