Dear Max,

I'm writing because I think you should know I'll have to leave town after lunch Thursday and wont be able to even try and do anything between that time and the middle or end of next week. I'll have to see my draft Board this weekend and I'll probably be in New York next week.

As of today, this is the status of your stuff at the Army: Several more chapters are approved and you should have them maybe by the time you get this. Of the six or seven remaining the only one with which there is any known difficulty is that on the Army Specialists Corps. If I possibly can I'll see if I can make the changes and get it approved, but because of the many things I have to do in so short a time - I had no idea I'd have to go before the draft board - there is an excellent chance I wont be able to.

If I can straighten it out I'll let you know, and if I cant I'm certain the Army will let you know.
