Among literary people, he is far and away the outstanding authority on the Don, the Don region and the Don people, who are perhaps the most colorful of Soviet peoples. A piece by him, on the subject, it seems to me, should have a large appeal to anyone who either knows their name, or whom there are many judging from the unusually favorable reception of his books in this US or is interested in our country, which it regrettably most people who read. Of course, the piece which he can write would be quite expensive for which you'd pay at your regular rates, and I pointed out that at the present time they are low.
