

U.S. Says No Other Data Sustain Eaton War Fears WASHINGTON, May 25 (AP) —A spokesman said today the State Department had no in-formation from other sources ulong the lines of a prediction oy Cyrus S. Eaton, the financier and industrialist, that the Unit-ed States was threatened by nuclear war with Communist China and the Soviet Union in China and the Soviet Union in a week to four weeks unless it stopped bombing North Vietnam.

nam. Mr. Eaton, just back from Prague, Budapest and Moscow, made his forecast yesterday in a speech to the Economic Club of Detroit.

of Detroit. He based it on remarks that he said Premier Aleksei N. Kosygin made to him last Thursday to the effect that the United States had declared war on the Soviet Union, that the Soviet Union was committed to the defense of North Vietnam and had "no alternative but to fight."
