Roy Zachary speak. McIlvane testified (pt. 31, p. 12780) abut this speech:

Well, he was discussing the actions of the President, and what was going on the the government; and this man said: "That will be eliminated, because President Roosevelt will be assinated."

Luse's testimony appears in the same book beginning on p. 12777.

Note. I testified to this incident and gave the Dies

Committee the citation and was closely cross-examined on it

by Congressmen Dempsey and Voorhis on 1/31/40, but when Pelley
subsequently appeared before the Dies committee he was not, so far
as I can discover, questioned about it.
