





President of Movimiento Universitario de Renovadora Orientacion (MURO - University Reform Movement) had called for the ouster of Cuban Ambassador JOAGUIN HERMANDEZ ARMAS from Mexico as persona non grata. The student leader said that the Ambassador and Cuba, through the First Tricontinental Conference, were behind much of the subversion and agitation in Mexico.

According to who has furnished reliable information in the past, MURO is a far right, nearly Facist student organization in Mexico, which claims to be a Catholic student organization.

According to the First Tricontinental Conference was held at mayana, Cuba, January 3 through 15, 1933. The majority of the delegates to this conference represented communist or communist-oriented groups in Africa, Asia, and Latin America. Many of the delegates represented terrorist groups engaged in guerrilla warfare in their respective countries. Resolutions passed at this conference were anti-United States and tended to unify dissident and subversive elements into a common front to attack everything noncommunist.


