Maldonado and Chavez are now attempting to absorb other pro-Chinese dissident factions of the PCM into the PCBM, including the LLE. They are also attempting to absorb the little group of dissidents of the PCM headed by Othon-Salazar Ramirez, pro-Communist leader of the Movimiento Revolucionario del Magisterio (MRM - Revolutionary Teachers' Movement). I Members of the latter group were previously followers of Ruben Jaramillo, a member of the PCM who was murdered in 1962.

The LLE, whose principal leader at the present time is Enrique Sonzalez Rojo, has about 50 bona fide members, but has a considerably larger number of sympathizers. Many left-wing young people, such as Silvia Tirado de Duran, a Mexican citizen and former employee of the Cuban Embassy in Mexico City, 2 and sympathizers of the LLE attend its study circles and meetings, but the majority are not formal members of the group.
