I have received your letter dated Oct. 27, denying my Presdom of Information Act petition concerning access to files the FDI and CIA have on me.

In regard to this letter, please send me a copy of Title 5 U.S.C. 552(b) (1) and (3) you cited in your letter. I have not seen these laws and do not know what you are talking about when you mention them.

I elso would like you to consider my special circumstances. In January of 1974, I was convicted of a felony -violation of narcotics law- in a New York district court. I must add and emphasize that I was innocent of these charges. According to my own investigations, I have discovered that the conviction involved some conspracy between agents of foreign government (Cuba) and agents of DEA (Drug Enforcement Agency) and CEA (Control Intelligency).

The information in my file can holp me clar my case and prove my innecence. The FBI and CIA files have data which is indispensable for my appeal. In short, the information is vital for obtaining my appeal in federal court.

I hope you can understand the importance of this information as it concerns my right to justice. Thank you so much for your time.
