In his memoirs of the Bay of Pigs operation Hunt gave Helms' code name inside the CIA -''Knight'' - to David Phillips. When Hhillips wrote his memoirs he conceded that he was the man Hunt called Knight, and commented, ''Bestowin the name of Knight was the ultimate accolade - people who have worked in CIA will recall that pseudonym belonged to one of the Agency's most senior officers, a man Hunt idolized.''
