Dear Mr. Weisberg:

I have two specific requests:

- l. I have a pamphlet from the War Department on the WAACs, giving in fairly complete form details of how a gal becomes an enlisted women. However, while the pamphlet mentions officers candidate schools for WAACs it gives none of the detaails: where they are, what subject are covered, and most important, how one gets into one. Can you get me a brief outline of all this, preferably a pamphlet if one exists.
- 2. I'm a bit confused on the matter of physical requirements for the Army. What I would like, if pessible, would be a simple outline of the requirements for an enlisted man, with brief mention of the special would ifications for such groups as West Point cadets, air corps flyers, air corps ground crew officers, commissioned officers, nurses, excx WAACS, etc. Do you think you can get me that. Otherwise I'd appreciate the pamphlet put out by Selective Service Headquarters on physical standards, which at least gives the basic requirements for simple admission into the army.

Also, can you get me a simple explanation of the pay bill, plus the wayx in which it affects dependents. The pay bill covers all services, so I'd also like some mention of the way in which it covers each.
