I believe I asked you for the Selective Service pamphlet which describes the physical requirements for enlisted men, in case you can't get a simplified outline of the requirements for enlisted men, commissioned men, West Pointers, warrant officers, etc. Those basic requirements also appear in ~~MR~~ MR 1-9, (Mobilization Regulations). I'd like ~~that~~ <sup>either</sup> right away.

Re Warrant Officers: does their pay remain the same as second lieutenants under the new pay bill? How does it go up?

Army Music School: Can you get me location (I believe it's in Washington) along with some brief description, length of course, curriculum, etc.

Army ~~Fla~~ Mine Planter Service: Has there been any expansion in this service? Anything of special interest about it?

Can you get anything about what will happen to enlistmen and officers after the war: how long will they stay in service? what happens to all these temporary commissions? To what status do ~~former~~ officers of the National Guard, Reserve Corps, etc., revert? I know this is all vague, but some word would be of interest.
