Dear Al,

Here is the Morgenthau piece, without a title. I am going to send Schw arz a copy tomorrow and I'll send you a copy of the letter I send him.

I expect to be able to write you about other things tomorrow or the next day.

I paid \$1.50 for typing this piece. The other piece, the one that they changed their mind on, ran longer, and I paid \$2.25 for typing it. Other expenses, including the period since I last sent you an expense account, two or three weeks ago, are: Messenger, 65¢; phones 55¢; cabs (inc. N.Y.) 2.45; trolley cars, 30¢; total, \$7.70.

Soon I'll write you the ~~next~~ letter I promised, covering all the things we discussed.
