Thanks for your letter and the check. I know it was all a mistake.

Please tell Al he was so long letting me know about the girl guerilla
story that first of all it has been so well covered in the press (and will
be in the reels) that I think it is now not as good as when I first wrote
about it. I think we'd best forget about that. Also please tell him I
think I can get a better 1st. person story along the same lines from
another and comparatively unpublicized member of the same party of
student-delegates, the lieutenant who killed 152 Nazis with 154 bullets.
I have a tentative okay on it at this end, and what remains is for us
to think if there is anything in particular we want. I'm to get in
touch with the press officer at the Soviet Embassy on this in the middle of
next week, and I think we could get a good, different, personal story on
the Red Army, the Soviet peoples and their resistance, and something on
the cementing of relations between them and us, which is the purpose of his
visit here and a delegate to Mrs. Roosevelt's ISS.
