Dear Mr. Alexis,

Thanks for your kind comments. (And please excuse my typing. ^It cannot be any better.)

You can't get the "Complete Whitewash" because it does not exist and when it does it will not have that confusing, if not misleading title.

Because we are both over 80, in less than perfect health, I agreed ^{to} a condensation of all my JFK works into a single book. I would not agree to the reprinting of any single one not so much because that would cost us sales but because it inevitably would require endless letters of explanation and much forwarding, more letters and time. It was explicit that it would not be a reprint of the first book. I don't know how that very wrong title was picked. When I learned about it, not from the publisher but from the announcement that book stores reacted to, I pointed out that the title could not possibly be that one.
