- Post Mortem: JFK Assassination Coverup Smashed


When President Kennedy was assassinated I was a 9-year-old fourth grader, too young to understand the significance of the event, though I remember being sad that our nice President had been killed. My parents had voted for Kennedy and had a portrait of him on the wall; my father was about the same age, and even bore a slight resemblance to President Kennedy. The likeness was close enough to confuse a 7-year-old; for some time after they hung the picture I thought it was a photo of my father and I remember realizing with a bit of a shock one day that it was not my father after all, but the President!

As I grew into adulthood I never thought much about the assassination, or the generally accepted conclusion that Oswald was the lone-nut assassin. It was not until one of my co-workers who was intrigued with the subject began discussing it that I became interested in obtaining more information.

I have checked "Whitewash" out from our local University library after noting that many authors listed it in their bibliographies, along with some of your other publications. It is obvious that a great deal of work went into this book; I also know that because of the political climate at the time, it took a great deal of courage to publish "Whitewash". All Americans owe you a huge debt of gratitude for publishing this book since it helped begin the process of questioning the conclusions of the Warren Commission; I personally want to thank you for writing it.
