Dear Mr. Weisberg,

As someone just old enough to remember the events of the weekend of November 22<sup>nd</sup>, 1963, I would never have imagined the impact that the assassination would have on me to this day. Starting with Josiah Thompson's *Six Seconds in Dallas*, which I read in the late sixties, I now have a collection of some sixty books on the subject, some accurate, some not so good. I, like anyone else with a sincere interest in the assassination, would someday like to find out 'the' answer to all the disturbing questions and not just 'an' answer. For this reason I've always found it interesting to read all material on the assassination, whether pro or con conspiracy. To this day, no author has been able to convince me that a conspiracy did not exist.

I bought Gerald Posner's book and began reading it with great anticipation, hoping to find that overlooked clue or that new testimony that would support his title of *Case Closed*, but I quickly became disturbed by his selective use of evidence. Having just finished your latest book, *Case Open*, I'm very relieved that there is a convincing rebuttal from a respected critic such as yourself.

It disturbs me greatly that someone may chose to read Posner's book as their first on the assassination and be convinced that no further reading on the subject is necessary. His book would be very convincing the uninited, and this is very unfortunate.

I am writing at this time in hopes of obtaining a price list for your other books (and shipping costs to Canada) as I have only about half of your publications and would like to add these to my library.

Eagerly awaiting the release of *Never Again*.
