Mr. Weisberg:

My wife and I have just finished reading your latest book *Case Open*. While we agree with you that *Case Closed* was quite possibly the worst book written regarding the Kennedy Assassination we must admit that while yours is filled with some very provocative facts the layout, and or editing, made reading it a challenge. None the less we enjoyed it and appreciate the time, effort, and energy it required.

I have long been a critic of the Governments official version of the events surrounding the Assassination, and several years ago won my wife over as well. I believe that the American public is slowly coming to the same conclusion that has been offered by such visionaries as yourself, Mark Lane, and Sylvia Meagher for years. Quite frankly it continues to amaze me that anyone can review the available information objectively and conclude that a conspiracy of monumental proportions did not, and does not, exist.

As I assume is the case with many folks my wife and I own most of the credible books ever published regarding this tragedy. Sadly, and with some embarrassment. we do not own any of yours, other than *Case Closed*. Not necessarily doing any new research, but providing a roadmap, if you will, for those uneducated folks that have not taken the time, or worse have read books like *Case Closed* and base their opinions on this misinformation. It seems to us that there has been plenty of research completed by people much better at it than ourselves; yourself, Cyril Wecht, Lane, Meagher among others, yet there does not appear to be one source that ties all these pieces together. Of course a person could devote an entire book to each aspect of the Assassination such as Dealey Plaza, who was there, what they saw, what they said, to whom, when, and why only those that supported the TSBD version ever got any play. Have you considered penning such a work?

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
