Mr. Weisburg,

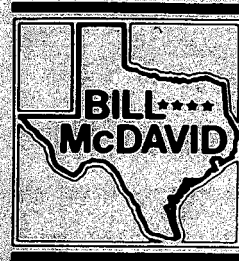
I wanted to take a moment to thank you for taking time out of your personal life to speak with me on Saturday.
