Marina do not worry, everything will be all right. As they say, the world is not without good people. Try to cheer up Lee. I remember him prior to his departure from the Union. Remember the quotations from Ilpha and Petrova, so, therefore, everything surmise greetings great country!

"I do not represent myself as Count Monte Cristo." Do not be hurt, but this is just a joke as it is we have work for everybody. Do come everything will be all right. Mhen you decide to come do write. I will meet you.
