Autopsy May Yield Clue in

College Death

Raleigh, N.C., Dec. 14 (AP)—Authorities awaited an autopsy report today to help determine cents surrounding the death of a North Carolina State University student in his dormitory room.

Raymond P. McCauley, 19, a sophomore from Charlotte, was found bound, gagged and strangled with an extension cord yesterday.

Assistant Wake County Goroner Truman Rhodes said indications at first were that the death
was an apparent suicide, "but
something came up that we
wanted to check on through an
autopsy." He declined to claborate.
