Autopsy May Yield Clue in College Death

Raleigh, N.C., Dec. 14 (AP)—
Authorities awaited an autopsy
report today to help determine
causes surrounding the death of a
North Carolina State University
student in his dormitory room.

Raymond P. McCauley, 19, a
sophomore from Charlotte, was
found bound, gagged and stran-
gled with an extension cord ves-
terday.

Assistant Wake County Cor-
oner Truman Rhodes said indica-
tions at first were that the death
was an apparent suicide, "but
something came up that we
wanted to check on through an
autopsy." He declined to elabo-
rate.
