

**New Orleans Grand Jury
Hears Warren Report Critic**

NEW ORLEANS, April 28 (AP) — The Orleans Parish (County) grand jury today heard Harold Weisberg, whose book, "Whitewash," was critical of the Warren Commission report on the assassination of President Kennedy.

District Attorney Jim Garrison, who has also challenged the commission's report, and four assistants accompanied Mr. Weisberg into the grand jury room.

There was no word of what evidence Mr. Weisberg might give the jury, which is investigating Mr. Garrison's charges that a plot was hatched in New Orleans for the 1963 assassination in Dallas. Mr. Garrison has charged Clay L. Shaw, 54 years old, a New Orleans businessman, with complicity in a conspiracy in the Kennedy slaying.

The Warren Commission re-

ported that Lee Harvey Oswald, who was shot to death shortly after the assassination, was solely responsible.
