Clawson Gets Communication Director Post

President Nixon appointed former Washington Post re-porter-Ken-W. Clawson as-communications director to

the President yesterday.

Clawson will be responsible for communicating Mr. Nixon's nolicies and programs to editors, publishers and broadcast executives throughout the county. He will be responsible to presidential press secretary Ronald L. Ziegler. The post pays \$40,000 a year.

Clawson will take over many of the duties formerly performed by Herbert G. Klein, a longtime Nixon associate who left the White House last summer and is now a broadcast director. on's policies and programs to
