an nonest and rank and file union, and WHEREAS, Instead of the Dies Committee expending all of their en-ergy and government money in in-vestigation of honest unions, why not designate them in a thorough investi-gation of the phoney Maritime Com-mission, which has sanctioned the transferring of American ships to for-eign flags, which will jeopardize the American merchant marine, and place thousands of American seamen out of work, so be it
