me there talking to him for 40 min.,
& I missed the news & part of the early
show. God how he ran on, repetitively
& proudly, & wouldn't let me leave.

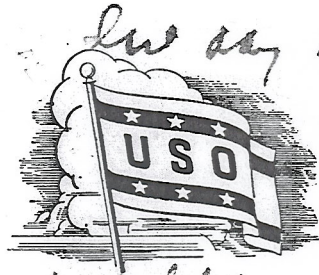
It made me unhappy, but it was
funny. This fellow is the one they
nick named "Gigam" and "Gigam
young" because he was always "gigging"
the boys, or talking their names in penalties.
Evidently, though he has just returned
from a 3-day pass, he was hungry for
companionship.

While I was in town last night some of the Class II men came in. Some know what they are - defectives, it is said, a man for weeks for recuperation & rehabilitation. I met one of the leaders who said he had fed 100 & they would, he said, a fair little fight in some cases.

I saw a pretty sight yesterday, though. One of the companies here has a platoon of "Presidential Guards" in training. They are carefully selected men, 6" a pop. They go to Hyde Park & the White House. Apparently it is considered a fine assignment in the MP's. Anyway, they looked good drilling.

There is still no news, though a rumor, attributed to a reliable source, of a 200 man up-stale shipment, has me uneasy. So is the one I have been worried about & would, I'm afraid, be the most inconvenient for us.

Tell me this, dad: if it is so uncertain that you don't come up here, & if I ship to reach a destination from which I could get home for just the



last day of the treatment period, which I believe is the 5th - would it be worthwhile?

I have in mind the possibility of being shipped to someplace overnight on a return trip & reaching there in time for just the one trip during the period. Would this not be worthwhile for the treatment? I thought it would be, but I wanted to know what you think. ~~There~~ Having no reason to believe I'd ship in the next day or so, I'm thinking in terms of the latter part of the period - hoping in those terms, too.

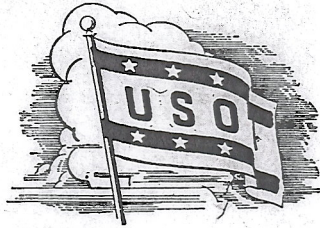
And for now I'll pass this away & add to it later if there is something to add.

Dear -

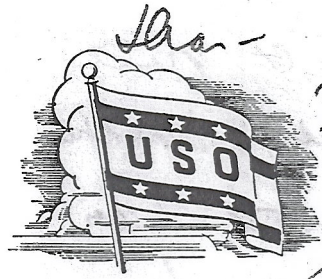
I am getting quite forgetful. I mean to enclose her with the letter of what a while ago I got.
