said he has known WEISBERG for a number of years and knows him to be in the poultry business. said he has seen helicopters fly over his own farm, however, he has never seen a helicopter flying over his house which he would consider too low. He pointed out that it is very difficult to judge the altitude of a helicopter flying over and for this reason could only say that he has never seen one flying at an altitude he would consider low enough to do damage to livestock or poultry.

pointed out that WEISBERG's farmhouse and poultry houses sit on the side of a hill. The buildings are near the bottom of this hill which is 400 or 500 feet high. He also pointed out that there are large trees in the wicinity of WEISBERG's farm.
