Synopsis

Plaintiffs filed claim against Government for \$9,950.00 for damages adlegedly sustained in poultry business as the result of low flying helicopters. Case tried and court directed judgment in favor of plaintiffs for \$750.00. Savings to Government \$9,200.00.

DETAILS: \(\sigma\)

On November 19, 1958, HAROLD and LILLIAN WEISBERG, filed a complaint in the United States District Court, District of Maryland, under the Federal Tort Claims Act for \$9,950.00 damages allegedly sustained by them in their poultry business as the result of a disturbance caused by low flying helicopters.

The records of the Clerk of the Court, United States District Court, Baltimore, Maryland, checked on May 1, 1961, reflect that this case was tried on April 12, 1961, and held subcuria on April 13, 1961.

On April 19, 1961, Judge ROSZEL C. THOMPSEN directed the entry of a judgment in favor of the plaintiffs in the sum of \$750.00

The savings to the Government in this matter totaled \$9,200.
