Dear Gary,

Thanks for the HSCA material on Dolce. Glad to have it and to know that when they ignored him they knew what they were doing.

I remain concerned about what you do to your reputation in espousing a version of what many are said to have said about the JFK headwound while not refuting the evidence that proves the interpretation of what they said is not so.

At the time of Christopher Columbus most of the people in Europe, include the best and the brightest, believed the world was flat. But it wasn't.

If you care about your reputation I suggest what I think I suggested before, that you have to prove the Zapruder film at about frames 335-6 was faked, and that means faked in every print of it; and that the faking of all prints was within physical possibility. They show quite clearly that the back of the head was not blown out.

What most people who are quoted were actually saying is that it was blown out toward the back.

Of course if you can prove that the Zapruder film was faked you'd then have to prove that the autopsy film was faked.

There is the simple fact and the simple question flowing from it I hope you will think about. The fact is that the existing autopsy film destroys the official assassination mythology. So, why, assuming it was known what had to be argued with the film at the time it was exposed, would anyone fake film to have it accomplish the exact opposite of the purpose of the alleged faking?

The <sup>WC</sup> staff report that includes Dolce is in facsimile in Post Mortem.

What Dolce told HSCA about the thigh wound having been <sup>caused</sup> by a sliver is what Perry told me and he saw, examined it. Also in Post Mortem. I think a measurement of it and <sup>in the X-rays</sup> perhaps also the fragment in Connally's chest would establish 399 could not have been the source.
