Of all the pictures of Veciana I have seen, this one  
is noted to be the clearest. I vaguely remember a Life issue that  
had a far worse shot of his face. It is not as clear as is  
needed for any identification purposes - - - -

#### A MINOR HISTORY OF VECIANA AND ALPHA 66 ( FROM A PRE - ASSASSINATION ARTICLE )

Back in 1960, a Cuban accountant named Antonio Veciana  
was working with other accountants, embezzling Government funds  
and trying to form an anti-Castro underground. That was the  
beginning of the organization. In the autumn of 1961, however,  
one Renaldo Gonzalez set up an elaborate plot to assassinate  
Castro. Veciana's mother rented an apartment near the Presidential  
place in Havana, and guns were secreted in the apartment.  
The plot was to shoot Castro while he was making one of his  
parade speeches. This particular plot, however, by Castro's  
secret police, inspired Gonzalez and two others were captured.  
But Veciana and his mother got away, and eventually escaped  
aboard to Florida - - -

In Miami, Veciana again gathered together a group  
of Cuban accountants who had taken refuge in the U.S. about  
two months ago. The accountants and others - 66 in all -  
were collecting money from Cubans, Americans, and others.

To finance their Alpha 66 campaign - With their money, the  
66 bought guns and boats, then recruited and trained  
Commandos.

## MORE ON ROCKWELL

"A letter, written to Time Magazine, Sept 15, 1944...  
after Rockwell was murdered." SIR: George Lincoln Rockwell  
was not a common hater or a backwoods bigot. He was  
embodiment of forensic eloquence and rapier-sharp wit,  
of which had been honed to a hair-thin cutting edge. His  
stature emitted strength as well as fear. The real tragedy  
Rockwell's demise is that such quality and potential could  
have been foiled by a twisted alignment with a Hitlerian  
fascist psychopath. And, more seriously, gone too is the  
assurance that if the Nazis had it for him, he would  
have escaped to the masses that he had  
so ardently identified with and served so well. He was  
perhaps a cabinet officer. His combat record is available.  
Please comprehend that in no manner do I  
endorse the tenets of Nazism. I reject the entire Nazi  
credo only wish Commander Rockwell had done the same.

Before he was killed, I heard Rockwell complain
