Shortly thereafter, with almost no attention, he surfaced as a teacher of espionage someplace in new York. That part appeared in either Time or Newsweek.

Last night's radio account say that Dita Beard's former secretary has provided what is described as a deposition refuting your original charge. I believe the use of the word "deposition", if by a lawyer, is designed as deception, if my understanding of deposition is correct. It is not merely a sworn q and a. A true deposition requires the presence of counsel for o posing sides.

The production of what is described as the real memo can be a help to you if you get a clear enough copy of it and understand what I had in mind in an earlier letter.
