Threats vs JFK - Miami; the 11/18/63 trip there EW 5/17/77

Another of the recently released Secret Service records is the 12/30/63 report of S.A. Ernest I. Aragon, approved by SAC John A. Marshall, not in a JFK assassination file from the number (1-16-602.111). The subject is this visit.

I have addressed this earlier, I think in writing back to SS about this.

All the possible incidents reported by Aragon were eliminated and were not the basis for any change in plans.

In this there is no reference to the Milteer-Somersett tape. (My file, NSRP-Miami tape.)

Yet it is over the Milteer threat, taped by the Miami police, that the motorcade was cancelled.

The Miami police gave both FBI and Secret Service dubs of the tape.

The informer Somersett was also an FBI informer, interviewed promptly after the assassination.

Throughout this report there are names that were subject to withholding because of what was said, like embarrassing the President. None was withheld.
