Assassination Kits
TAMPA, Fla. — Frank Seeley, a Fort Myers gunsmith charged with manufacturing "assassination kits," has been sentenced to 22 years in federal prison.

U.S. District Judge Gerald B. Tjoflat, who passed sentence, said, "We have a case where people were making weapons to assassinate people — like judges, officials and citizens."

Seeley, 38, was convicted last October of 18 violations of firearms laws in the manufacture of black attache cases fitted with sawed-off rifles and silencers.
