I have had some inforturate experiences with fluke accidents not to want to have a space on hand.

If there are any costs involved, please bill me. I have not heard from Mr. Morey but assume that he is still willing to do them. I certainly appreciate all the trouble you have gone to on this score for me.

By now you must be almost into court, Best of luck there. A decision in your favor could be a very important event in the struggle for an open and innest inquiry into the President's assassination.
