Re Dallas airtel to Bureau dated 12/11/67 and Bulet dated 12/18/67, enclosing results of Laboratory examination of cartridge turned over to FBI by MR. WILLIAM A. BARBEE; and Bureau telephone call to Dallas 12/27/67 requesting further clarification concerning location of this cartridge with respect to its proximity to the Texas Schoolbook Depository.

On 12/29/67, SA WALLACE R. HEITMAN and Investigative Clerk STEVE D. ALBRIGHT surveyed the area of 1615 Stemmons Freeway, Dallas, Texas, and noted the following:

1615 Stemmons Freeway is at a location approximately one mile north, as the crow flies, from the Texas Schoolbook Depository. From the ground at 1615 Stemmons Freeway, the Texas Schoolbook Depository building cannot be seen. From the ground at the Texas Schoolbook Depository, the building at 1615 Stemmons Freeway cannot be seen. Bearing in mind that LEE HARVEY OSWALD fired from the Southeast 6th floor window of the Texas Schoolbook Depository, the building at 1615 Stemmons Freeway would not be in any way in the line of fire.
