Compromise Seen for 9 At Southern

— Compromise appeared near today in a suit filed by Southern University administrators to bar nine student protest leaders from the Baton Rouge

campus.

Attorneys for the university and the nine students con-ferred with each other Wednesday, then with state Dist. Judge Lewis Doherty. They were to get together again this morning, before the resumption of the hearing.

There was speculation uni-

versity officials would allow the students to return to classes—but only with the understanding that they are not to disrupt the academic proc-

Doherty said attorneys had agreed to call no further wit-

nesses.

Several Southern instructors testified Wednesday that student boycotters entered classrooms in an effort to swell their ranks.
