Dear Harold:

There is one last photograph to be taken in connection with the D.I. photo. I want to give you a copy of the photo. You will recall that the P-I photo was taken from the D.I. building, and that the caption revealed that this was the sniper's nest.

Enclosed are three scanned photos. The first shows a photo that was published in the 14 Dec. 1956 issue of the Standard Evening Post. The second shows the P-I and P-I pictures together, with some printed notes of my own. The third shows a picture page of C.I. 575, which was published in the Secret Service on 7 December 1956.

The combination of objects (two of concrete structure) on the left side of each picture (Post and P-I) indicates that they were both taken from the same location, and the Post photo clearly shows that this location is <sup>on a</sup> second floor window of the Dal-Her building.

Even more interesting is this: The car in the Post photo is identical to the one in the Secret Service photo of C.I. 575 - a 1957 Lincoln-Continental convertible. The license number of the car in the Post photo is 37-1704. Can you tell me the license number of the car in C.I. 575? It is not at all clear in the Commission's photo. In any case, it is very likely that the two pictures show the same car.

The Post picture evidently was not taken simultaneously with the P-I picture. The occupants are different, and the Post car seems to be part of a procession; there is a car in front of it and one behind it. The P-I photo shows the north side of St. in the P-I photo indicates that the P-I photo was exposed at a different time from the P-I picture (where the car is evident), but that the car is not visible in the Post picture.

The caption of the P-I picture indicates that it was taken from the P-I photograph. Both the Post photograph and the Post picture, but I could not be surprised if they got it from the Secret Service. The technique of photographing through a scope is used in both pictures.

I shall make inquiries and try to find out the source of the Post photo. It may be worthwhile to compare that Post car with it.

I am sending copies of this to ~~you~~ and to Har. Gary loaned me the Post picture for copying, and I have some suggestions regarding what the combination of pictures shows.

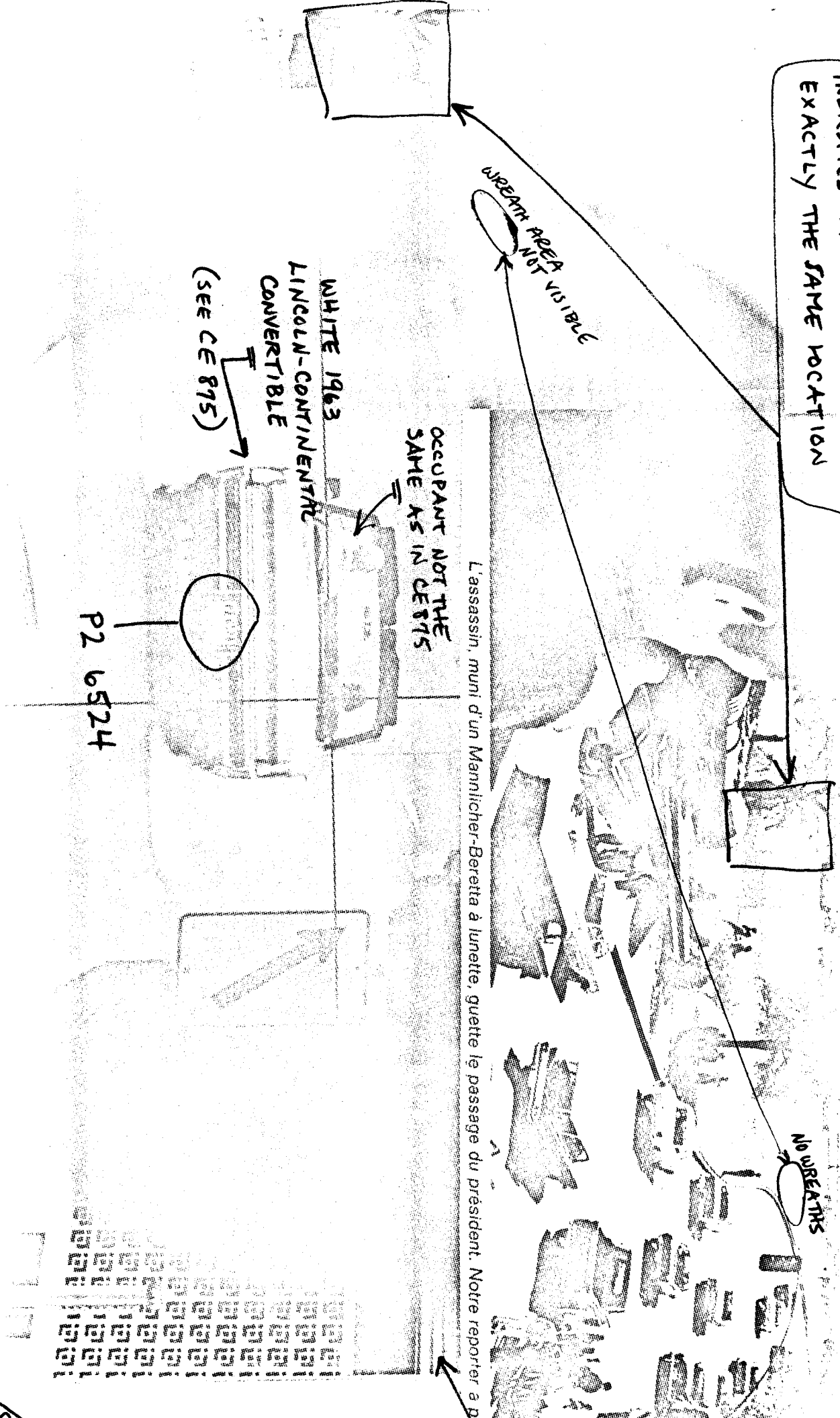

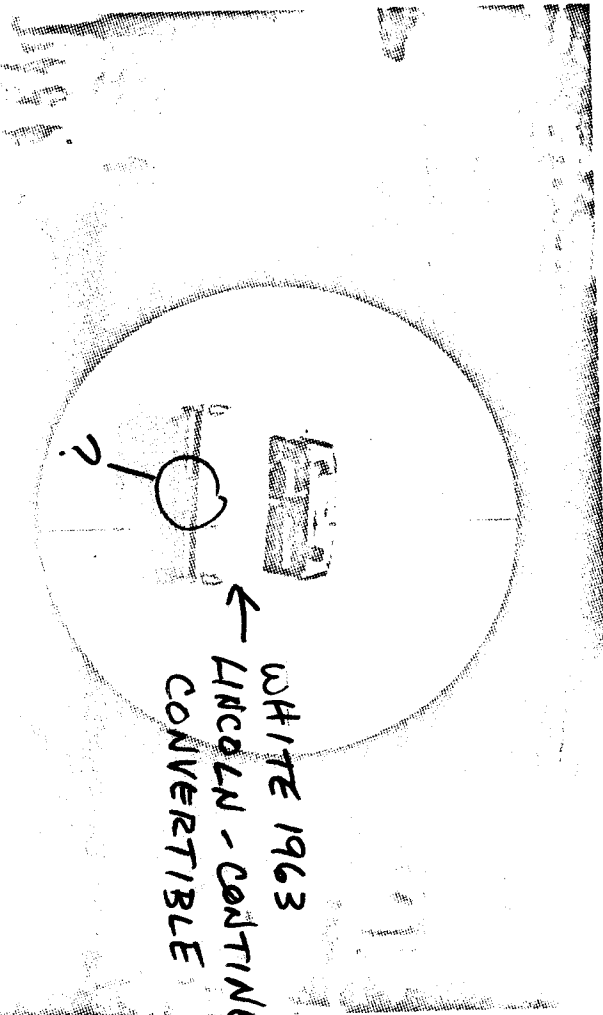
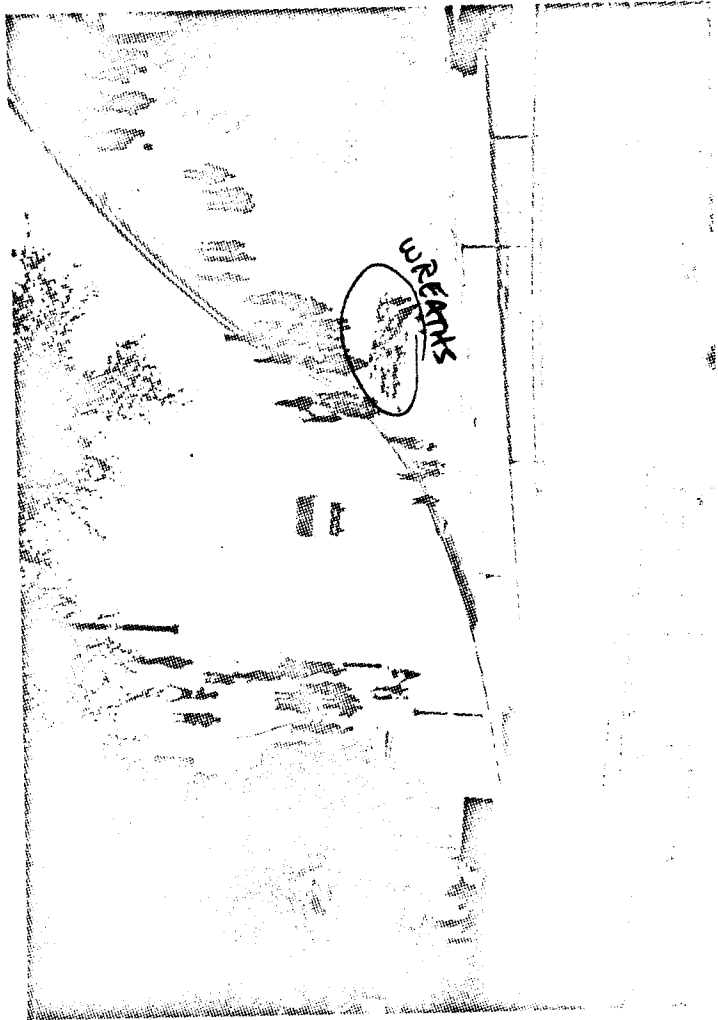
