Non-compliance with the E.O. on classification

Although classified 10-10-70-1970 it is classified confidential. It is not classified in accord w/ the requirements of the E.O. and it does not have a classification or having been reviewed, even by the forever classifying, HRC, who found almost anything except from downgrading or declassification.

The subject is "Information concerning" the long-deceased Boggs, who was a member of the House and will always be public property. Any information relating to him and suitable for filing in the suspect action file is of historical importance, even if it is no more than his reaction to the House giving his徒步 staff silent those who criticized it, including me. (It did, although no records of it have been provided.)

Clearly none of his activities can be reasonably segregated.

Within this is represented as below a member of the Communist Party. Clearly this is hurtful to her. It also is in sharp contrast with other allowances by the FBI in alleged protection of the rights of privacy of citizens. If the FBI can properly disclose its belief that someone is a member of the CP there would appear to be nothing it can properly withhold on a claim of privacy.
